(cryogenic 1.5 hours) User behaviour & perceptions, hazards caused by cryogen, asphyxiation, oxygen enrichment, pressure, carbon dioxide & dry ice, embrittlement, functions of pressurised vessels, dewars, ice plugs, cryogen in lifts, cryogenic spillage & emergency, procedures, PPE, First aid.

Practical Session approximately

(1 hour) All learners will be given the opportunity to practice under supervision before use checks, regulator fitting, manual handling of cylinders.

Certification & CPD Accredited Hours

Successful learners will receive a documented Certificate of Achievement with 4.5 or 6 CPD hours & the credit card style PGS Gas Safety Passport.
